SLHS's Grabow and Patrick to Sign Athletic Scholarship Offers

(Carson City, NV., January 30, 2012) – Sierra Lutheran High School seniors Becky Grabow and Tiffany Patrick have accepted collegiate athletic scholarships in their respective sports of cross country and volleyball and will sign their letters-of-intent on Wednesday.

Grabow, who is the two-time defending 1 & 2A NIAA State Champion in girls' cross country and the two-time defending 1A state champion in the 1,600m and 3,200m, has accepted a scholarship to compete in cross country and track at the University of Pacific in Stockton, CA, a NCAA Division I institution that competes in the Big West Conference.

"I am excited with what God has blessed me with" said Grabow, who is the first NCAA Division I scholarship athlete in school history. "And I want to give Him all the glory for what is to come."

Patrick, who was voted the 2011 Most Valuable Player of the 1A Northern Region Western League in girls' volleyball, has accepted a scholarship to compete at Concordia University, Seward, NE, a NAIA Division II institution that competes in the Great Plains Athletic Conference.

"I'm very grateful for everything Concordia has provided," said Patrick, who led SLHS to a 12-2 league finish last season and the school's first appearance in the State Tournament. "This sort of opportunity doesn't happen very often. It's such an honor to continue playing volleyball after high school, particularly at a Christian school."
